# Fellow of the American Carbon Society

## I. NAME

The award shall be known as Fellow of the American Carbon Society. The award will be administered, presented, and financed by the American Carbon Society.

## II. PURPOSE

To recognize members of the American Carbon Society for: (i) a sustained contribution in the field of science or technology of carbon materials, (ii) a recent significant accomplishment in the field of science or technology of carbon materials, or (iii) services to the American Carbon Society.

## III. NATURE OF AWARD

1. A suitable plaque
2. Life membership in ACS at no cost
3. At the discretion of the ACS Executive Committee, financial assistance with travel costs to receive award may be paid

## IV. ELIGIBILITY

All workers in the field of carbon science who are currently society members, or have been society members during the last ten years, are eligible to be nominated for this award. Nominees will typically have been members of the American Carbon Society for more than ten years. There will be no restriction as to race, creed, color, nationality, age, or sex of nominees or recipients. Posthumous awards will be made only when knowledge of the awardee's death is received after the announcement of the of the award committee's decision. Nominations of known deceased persons will not be accepted.

## V. FREQUENCY AND NUMBER OF AWARDS

The award(s) shall be presented at each American Carbon Conference. There shall be no limit to the number of persons receiving this award per conference.

## VI. NOMINATION

A nomination secretary, appointed by the Executive Committee of the American Carbon Society, is responsible for accepting and processing nominations.

## VII. SELECTION

A selection committee, of at least three anonymous members of the American Carbon Society, is responsible for selecting the recipient(s) of the award.

## VIII. PRESENTATION OF THE AWARD

The recipients will be invited to attend the American Carbon Conference Awards presentation ceremony, which will be held in connection with the awarding of the SGL, Pettinos, Mrozowski, Walker, and Graffin Awards.
